


Question: How can I create organised storage for screws and other bits?

Answer: Keep your screws separate and organised by simply using an old jar which you can create your own storage solution with so you never have to spend ages looking for a particular size again!


Storage for Screws and Bits...

You Will Need:


- ✓ A jar with a screw lid
- ✓ Hammer
- ✓ Nail
- ✓ Screwdriver
- ✓ Screws
- A shelf




We recommend using a plastic jar with a screw lid to prevent any breakages.



Using a hammer and nail, make 3 holes in the lid of your jar. Do this on a spare piece of wood to prevent damaging any work surfaces...



Attach the jar lid to the underside of a shelf using 3 screws that are shorter in length than the depth of the shelf...



Screw the jars back onto the lids. Now you have convenient clear jars to store screws and bits in. You can label them with sizes too!
